From the Principal

Reports – more than academic

Students will soon receive their mid-year progress reports. In the reports a variety of information will be provided about your child and their learning. I encourage parents and caregivers to not just focus on academic progress, although this is of course important. How is your child growing and developing socially and emotionally? What effort does my child show when learning?

Effort and growth mindset are closely aligned. A talented violinist doesn't just happen to become talented – they need to put in the effort. They need to practise, focus, prioritise their time. A talented tennis player doesn't just happen to become talented – they need to put in the effort. A talented learner doesn't just happen to grow in their learning unless appropriate effort is applied.

I sometimes refer to students needing a toolkit of skills and habits to help with their learning. Applying appropriate effort is certainly part of that toolkit. Having a growth mindset is also an invaluable part of a learner's toolkit. A growth mindset means having a belief that effort and attitude determine ability, that growth occurs through challenges.

Devotional Thought

The oldest birthday party in the world

'I have told you this while I am still with you. The Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and make you remember all that I have told you. 'Peace is what I leave with you; it is my own peace that I give you. I do not give it as the world does. Do not be worried or upset; do not be afraid.' (verses 25-27)

Read <u>John 14:8-17, 25-27</u>

Did you have a birthday party on Sunday? No, I don't mean for your birthday—unless, of course, Sunday was your birthday. I mean a party in celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit, in celebration of Pentecost, the church's birthday. On Sunday the church turned approximately [1993] years old.

And because a small group of ordinary people received the gift of the Holy Spirit, and three thousand people were baptised on that first Pentecost day, and those people shared the good news with their friends, we celebrate the day again today.

In this reading Jesus shows us the benefits of being part of the church. Through the Son we have access to the Father. Because of what Jesus did the day after he discussed these things with his disciples, we have peace—real peace, not just the absence of hostility, which is all human peace tends to be. It is peace that comes only through forgiveness and reconciliation.

And we have the Holy Spirit. The Spirit points us to Jesus and his teachings, gives us faith to believe in Jesus and to claim his promises, and helps us understand, confess and proclaim the good news of the grace of God.



2020 Three-year-old Kindergarten Information Sessions

The State Government has announced subsidised funding for up to 15 hours of 3-year-old kindergarten commencing in the Hindmarsh Shire as of 1 January 2020.

This State Government subsidised funding means the cost of 3-year-old kindergarten will be significantly reduced for all families and children of families with an eligible concession card will have access up to 15 hours of free kindergarten in 2020.

In order for HDKA to determine how many days, hours and what programs they will offer for both 3 and 4-year-old Kindergarten in 2020 we require kindergarten registrations for next year by **Friday 28 June 2019**.

There will be limited places available in 2020 and it imperative that we receive your kindergarten registration early in order for you to secure your kindergarten place.

HDKA will be hosting an information evening to answer any questions families may have in regard to the rollout of subsidised 3-year-old kindergarten in 2020 and provide information on both 3 & 4 year old kindergarten programs for next year. We encourage families to come along to the information evening as we hope to have more information and details to share with you all.
